### Awards

- We are pleased to offer up to 4 Financial Scholarships to students who will be enrolled in a higher education institution during the 2019-2020 school year.
- **SCC Scholarship** - Must be a regular attendee or member of Sanctuary Covenant Church (\$1,500 and \$1,000 scholarship awards)
- **Community Scholarship** - Must graduate from a North Minneapolis High School. (\$1,500 and \$1,000 scholarship awards)
- Awarded scholarships will be paid directly to the academic institution upon proof of enrollment for the 2019-2020 School Year.
- **North Park University Matching Grant** — Scholarship recipients attending North Park University(NPU) are eligible for an NPU (PIE) Grant that will match your award up to \$500/semester. To be eligible, student must be an active part of an Evangelical Covenant Church.
